Postcode format in the world

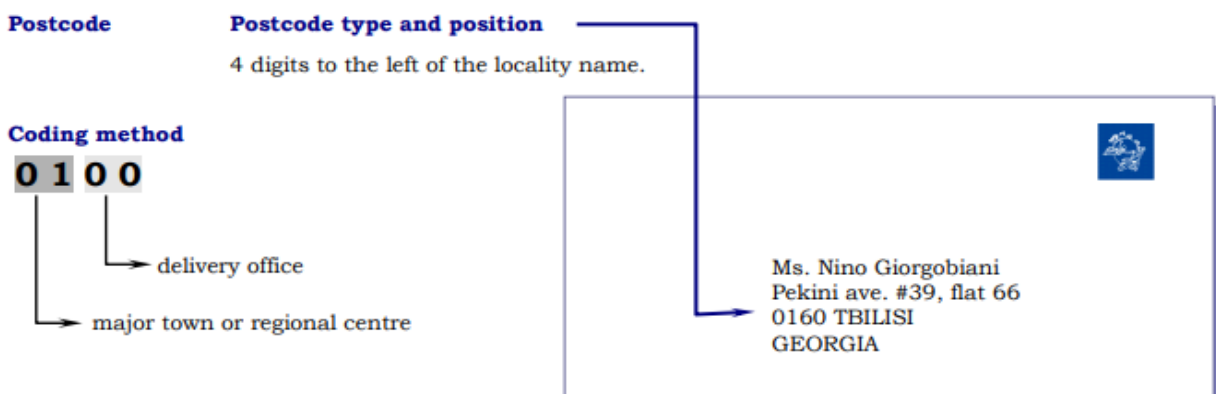
Different countries have diverse approaches to defining their postcode systems, including their placement within addresses, mandatory usage and alphanumeric composition. Understanding these details is crucial for correct address processing. Therefore, we publish the list summarizing postcode formats per country, indicating whether they are mandatory, which countries use postcodes and their composition, available for download at: [Postcode Formats](#)

Georgia: new data at premise level

The current release of the Universal *POST*CODE*[®] DataBase provides new addressing data for Georgia at street address level. The Georgia dataset contains more than 10,000 streets and street number ranges and 3,910 records at locality level.

The national postcode is composed of four digits to the left of the locality name. The first two digits represent the major town or regional centre and the second part represents the delivery office.
