
## Morocco



#### **Adress format**

Rules for writing postal addresses are as follows:

- Information must be ordered from the name of the addressee to the locality.
- No punctuation (dash, comma...) from the line containing the name and street number onwards.
- All address lines must be written in capital letters.
- Each address lines must not exceed 38 characters or spaces.
- Character fonts must be between 2 and 7 mm.
- Exact postcode of the locality, sector or agency must be written before the locality name of the addressee.
- All address lines are left aligned when address is written in Latin characters and right aligned when written in Arab.
- Address elements must not exceed 6 lines for inbound mail and 7 lines for international mail as described hereafter.
