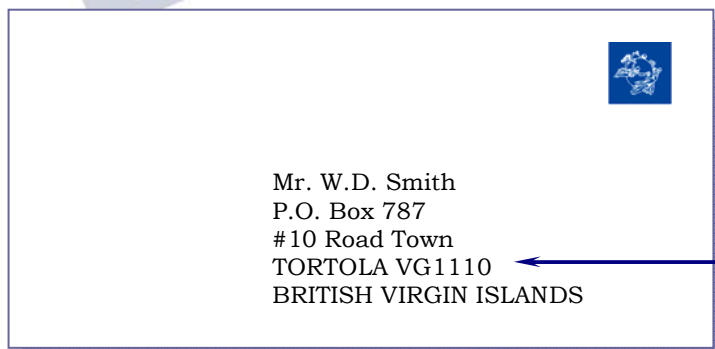
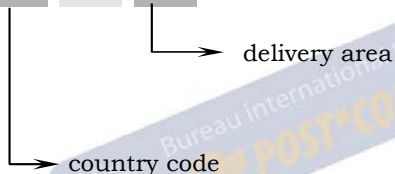
Postcode Postcode type and position

According to the most recent information, the British Virgin Island Post has developed a new postcode coming into effect on October 2006.

The new postcode is composed by 4 digits to the right of the locality name and preceded by "VG".

Coding method

V G 1 1 1 0



Position of the address on the envelope

Bottom right-hand corner



Alignment of address lines

Left-aligned



Address format

A correct postal address must contain a minimum of information needed for correct sorting and delivery, and will include a number of the following elements:

Addressee identification
P.O. Box number
Building Thoroughfare
LOCALITY POSTCODE
BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

The postcode must be written on the last (domestic) or penultimate (international) line of the address to the right of the locality name.

Please note that, as there are no home deliveries, the postcode should be linked to the P.O. Box location or to the post office from which the customers collect their mail.

Postcodes should be written on the same line as the locality name. The country name should appear on its own in the final line
