The postal administration of the **NETHERLANDS ANTILLES** asks me to inform the postal administrations of Union member countries of the following:


"On 28 August 2006, the Netherlands Antilles issued a personalized stamp sheet without denominations. However, this new stamp sheet contains the words "local" and "international". Stamps from the local stamp sheet can be used for local mail up to 20 grammes and stamps from the international stamp sheet for postcards only. "Reproductions of the local and international stamp sheets being issued by our postal administration are annexed hereto."
