Tanzania (United Rep.) – Postage stamp
with no face value

Dear Sir/Madam

The postal administration of **TANZANIA (UNITED REP.)** asks me to inform the postal administrations of Union member countries of the following:

"On 24 August 2006, the United Republic of Tanzania released a single, non-denominated stamp for "Europe postage" to commemorate the Phila-Africa Stamp Exhibition held in Dar es Salaam from 24 to 27 August 2006. This stamp depicts the famous highest mountain in Africa, Mount Kilimanjaro.

"The stamp may be used in combination with other valid Tanzanian postage stamps for prepayment of postage on international items.

"Tanzania Posts Corporation requests that UPU member countries consider postal items bearing such stamps (alone or in combination with other postage stamps) as having been duly prepaid.

"A reproduction of the stamp is annexed hereto."
