Slovakia – Issue of postage stamps without
face value

Dear Sir/Madam

The postal administration of **SLOVAKIA** asks me to inform the postal administrations of UPU member countries of the following:

On 28 February 2008, Slovenska posta, a.s. issued a postage stamp entitled "Easter 2008" with the inscription "T2 50g", which corresponds to the postal tariff for a second class letter up to 50 grammes in the domestic service. The postage stamp will be valid in both the domestic and international services from 28 February until it is withdrawn.

On 6 March 2008, Slovenska posta, a.s. issued a postage stamp in the "Towns" series – "Krupina", with the inscription "T2 100g", which corresponds to the postal tariff for a second class letter up to 100 grammes in the domestic service. The postage stamp will be valid in both the domestic and international services from 6 March 2008 until it is withdrawn.
