Aruba - Personalized stamps

Dear Sir/Madam

The postal administration of **ARUBA** asks me to inform the postal administrations of Union member countries of the issue, on 1 January 2009, of a "personalized stamp" special souvenir sheet containing six stamps, with no indication of the face value. This souvenir sheet bears the inscription "A Personal Souvenir from Aruba", and each stamp is intended for prepayment of a local or airmail letter weighing up to the first weight step, irrespective of future postage revisions.

Aruba Post requests that destination member countries consider postal items bearing one of the stamps from the souvenir sheet as having been duly prepaid. Such items should be handled and delivered normally in their countries, unless they bear the "T" indication of insufficient payment.

These stamps are shown in the Annex.
