The designated postal operator of **CAMEROON**, Campost (Cameroon Postal Services), asks us to inform the designated operators of UPU member countries of the following:

"Campost has learned of the existence of illegal postage stamps purportedly issued by Cameroon, which are being offered for sale on the Internet. One website offers an Elvis Presley collection which includes a postage stamp marked "Republic of Cameroon", supposedly issued in 2005 to mark the 70th anniversary of Elvis Presley's birth.

"Campost wishes to make it clear that this issue is not an official one. Cameroon has never produced a postage stamp with a picture of Elvis Presley, nor a stamp commemorating the anniversary of the singer's birth.

"Campost is, however, pleased to announce the issue of a postage stamp commemorating Pope Benedict XVI's first visit to Africa. The stamp is available through the Campost website at [www.campost.cm](http://www.campost.cm)."
