Stamp issues for the International Year of Biodiversity 2010

Dear Sir/Madam.

The United Nations General Assembly has declared 2010 to be the International Year of Biodiversity (IYB).

The International Bureau is therefore inviting the designated operators of UPU member countries to include in their 2010 or 2011 stamp programme one or more stamps and philatelic products marking this event.

Each participant country is free to issue such stamps according to its own schedule during the 2010/2011 period, and may decide independently on the illustration theme for its issue. Guidelines have been drawn up for use of the logo, slogan, images and related communications.

The Secretary of the Convention on Biological Diversity has informed the UPU that it is willing to assist countries planning stamp issues with the necessary formalities.
