The designated operator of **SWEDEN**, PostNord Group AB, would like to inform other Union member countries and their designated operators of the following:

“In March 2021, PostNord Group AB introduced a mobile postage service for international letter-post items. The mobile postage service enables mobile telephone users to frank priority letters from Sweden to addresses abroad via a mobile postage code. The postage code, which is hand-written, is illustrated below as an example.

“In compliance with articles 06-001 and 06-003 of the Regulations to the Convention, PostNord Group AB takes this opportunity to inform other Union member countries and their designated operators that the use of mobile postage codes as referred to herein has been formally authorized by PostNord Group AB as a postal prepayment impression. PostNord Group AB would therefore ask the designated operators of other Union member countries to notify their respective mail units and post offices accordingly.

“In this regard, PostNord Group AB would also point out that the term ‘Sverige’, as illustrated above, reflects the Swedish name of the member country Sweden, in accordance with the requirements outlined in article 06-003 of the Regulations to the Convention.
