

Berne, 13 June 2022 International Bureau Circular **96** Commemorative issue for World Post Day on 9 October 2022

The International Bureau wishes to invite Union member countries and their designated operators to celebrate World Post Day on 9 October through a commemorative stamp issue.

A special stamp (see Annex 1) has been created by the International Bureau for the occasion and will be available to UPU member countries in Arabic, English, French, Portuguese, Russian and Spanish. Issuing postal authorities can personalize the stamp and its philatelic elements through a complimentary service provided by the International Bureau. Postal authorities will not be required to sign a contract with the UPU for the issue of these philatelic items.
