

Dear Sir/Madam,

The designated operator of **GHANA**, Ghana Post Company Limited (Ghana Post), would like to inform other Union member countries and their designated operators that it has recently learned of the circulation of an illegal postage stamp issue in the name of Ghana, entitled “Mahatma Gandhi and Martin Luther King” (as shown in Annex 1).

It wishes to point out that these postage stamps have not been designed or issued by Ghana Post (as the relevant stamp issuing authority for Ghana), nor has Ghana Post given any formal authorization for their issuance by third parties.

Union member countries and their designated operators are therefore kindly asked to refrain from any form of transaction in this illegal postage stamp issue, and to reject any acceptance thereof for postal prepayment or philatelic purposes.

Ghana Post informs Union member countries and their designated operators that it will be addressing this matter domestically by ensuring that its operational and security departments remain vigilant against any attempts to use or sell such illegal postage stamps on the territory of Ghana.

Ghana Post thanks Union member countries and their designated operators for their cooperation in this matter.
