Franz Schubert (Vienna, 31.01.1797 – Vienna, 19.11.1828), Austrian composer, one of the first and main representatives of romanticism in musical creation. He showed a great talent for composing already at an early age. He composed symphonies and over six hundred solo songs, known as Lied - for voice and piano, and his source was verses by Goethe, Schiller and other poets. Among the most famous, we can single out Serenade, Ave Maria, Rose in the Grove, Beautiful Miller, Winter Journey and others. His fame was brought to him by the Great Symphony in C major composed in 1828 and the Unfinished Symphony in B minor composed in 1822. He died at the peak of his musical creativity, very young, in 1828 in Vienna.

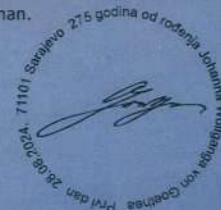

150 years of UPU

The Universal Postal Union (UPU) was founded on October 9, 1874 in Berne, when representatives of 22 countries of the International Postal Conference signed the Berne Postal Treaty, which established the first joint convention on international postal traffic. This year, UPU celebrates its 150th anniversary. A century and a half later, the UPU now unites the postal networks of 192 member countries, having realized its founders' vision of establishing a single postal territory to serve people everywhere. Today, with 192 member countries, including Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH was admitted to the Universal Postal Union on July 1, 1892 and again on January 26, 1993), it represents the primary forum for international postal cooperation and strengthening the global postal network.

The Buna Canals are a geomorphological phenomenon on the Neretva River in Bosnia and Herzegovina. The Bun Canals, located 12 kilometers south of Mostar and about 100 meters from the M-17 highway, are a natural phenomenon that attracts an increasing number of tourists every year. The main canal through which the Neretva flows for about 850 meters is about 3 meters narrow and as much deep, while its left tributary, the Buna, flows into it over a travertine barrier, creating a long line of waterfalls, depending on seasonal water levels of at most 2 meters in height.

There are many specifics about the river Miljacka. One of them is that the Miljacka originates from two united rivers, the Paljanska Miljacka, which rises southeast of the center of Pale on the northern slope of Ravna mountain in the form of stronger gravity-type karst springs (altitude 1010 meters) and the Mokranjska Miljacka, which rises under the branches of the mountain Romanija (altitude 1130 m above sea level) from a long underground cave, from which it emerges as a whole stream. A much more famous and attractive source is certainly the source of Paljanska Miljacka, which is located about 20 kilometers southeast of the center of Sarajevo.

KOZICE WATERFALLS FROM FOJNICA

One of the numerous natural sights of Fojnica, also described as the jewel of the Fojnica rivers, the Kozica waterfalls, is about ten kilometers from the city. In the forest environment, falling down steep rock cliffs, on the mountain river Kozica with crystal clear and cold water, several smaller and two larger waterfalls, whose height ranges from 5 to 20 meters, have formed.

The old town of Sokolac was first mentioned in 1369 as "Sokol", and it is claimed that it was built in 1020. He had his own courtier, crew and estates to support him. In the gallery of his masters, we meet the princes of Frankopana, Ivan Korivna, Orlović and Kerečani. After the fall of Bihać to Ottoman rule in 1592, a čehaja, an assistant to the Bihać captain, was appointed in Sokolac, and this city will be an exclusive military stronghold all the time, until 1878, when the military crew leaves it.

During the Austro-Hungarian period, villas were built along the Great Alley on Ilidža (an attractive promenade with about 3,000 chestnut and sycamore trees planted in a double row, more than a hundred years old, which is part of the protected "Vrelo Bosne Nature Monument" in the second zone protection, as well as in the water protection zone). The villas were built by the then Land Government as rural facilities for their own needs. The presence of villas gives a special cultural and historical value to this complex. One type are villas with a noticeable association with loggias and towers, and the other type are villas with a rectangular base where the floor and attic have a facade treated in a skeletal wooden structure.

The town of Karići is a place of history, tradition and customs. It is located on the slopes of Zvijezda Mountain in the middle of the Bosnian Forest. On a pointed rock 500 meters high, next to the Sarajevo-Zvornik road, not far from the confluence of the Jadar River and the Drinjača River, is the Kušlat Fortress, and inside it, like a bird's nest, is the small wooden Kušlat Mosque. The name Kušlat (derived from the word "kuš" which means bird in Turkish) dates back to the Ottomans, and the local population adopted this name, which has remained to this day. It was built by Ottoman soldiers immediately after their arrival in Bosnia, and for this reason it is considered the first military mosque in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Due to its very long lifespan, this mosque has an extremely significant value as an architectural and cultural-historical asset.

The Academy of Fine Arts in Sarajevo (AFA), which is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year, was founded as a higher education institution and a member of the University of Sarajevo in 1972. The building of today's Academy of Fine Arts in Sarajevo is the first and only evangelical church built in 1899 according to the designs of the Czech architect Karl Paržika in the Romanesque-Byzantine style as a central under-domed building.

The Sarajevo Philharmonic is the first professionally organized symphony orchestra in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and it had its roots already in the ensembles that were formed during the Austro-Hungarian rule. Since 1923, the existence of this orchestra represents one of the pillars of musical culture and an institution of fundamental importance for Sarajevo and Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Ancient mosaic from the Roman villa in Stolac at the end of the 2nd and beginning of the 3rd century AD.

A mosaic with the personification of the seasons was found in a Roman villa in Stolac in 1892. Only half of the mosaics with the personification of the seasons have been preserved. Two irregular rhombuses are inscribed in the quadrilateral field, which intersect to form an octagon. The central field of the octagon is destroyed except for the two corners which depict the personification of spring and winter.

Pontechium maculatum is a Natura 2000 species that covers mainly the central and eastern part of the Balkan Peninsula. The habitats of this species, which comes from the sedge family, in Bosnia and Herzegovina are limited exclusively to serpentine habitats.

Onosoma L. is one of the most important genera of the sedge family, which includes about 150-230 species distributed in Southeastern Europe and Anatolia, as well as Eastern, Western and Central Asia. It belongs to a group of species ($2n=22$) that are characteristic of the Western Balkans.

Neapolitan cyclamen is a perennial plant with a height of 10-20 cm, with a tuber size of 3-5 cm, in the upper half with root hairs and leaf stalks. The leaves are elongated heart-shaped, kidney-shaped or spear-shaped with irregular edges. The genus *Cyclamen* L. includes over 20 species, in addition to a large number of cultivars that mainly differ in the shape and color of flowers and leaves, some varieties are also grown as houseplants. In Bosnia and Herzegovina, 3 types of cyclamen have been identified: *Cyclamen hederifolium* Aiton - Neapolitan cyclamen, *Cyclamen purpurascens* Mill. - forest cyclamen and *Cyclamen repandum* Sibth. et Sm. - coastal cyclamen).

Softmouth trout - *Salmo obtusirostris*.

Bosnia and Herzegovina has been home to 119 species of salmonid and cyprinid fish, many of which are endemic and unique in the world. The soft-mouthed trout is an endemic fish species of the Neretva River basin, and according to the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) since 1996 it has been on the Red List as a threatened species.

Yellow water lily - *Nuphar lutea* (L.)

belongs to the water lily genus (*Nuphar* Sm.) and the water lily family (Nymphaeaceae). In Bosnia and Herzegovina, only the following species has been recorded: *Nuphar lutea* (L.) Sm. - yellow water lily (Beck-Mannagetta, 1909). The yellow water lily is a perennial herbaceous plant whose root is horizontal, cylindrical, white on the inside, and yellowish green on the outside, located in the muddy soil of stagnant water.
