Gallal is a percussion instrument. All known old types of gallal are made from clay, leather or rope. There are three types of gallal instrument, a large instrument called (El-Khellaf), a medium-sized instrument called (Er-Rbâa) and a third small one known as (El-Aridja). They are in fact common instruments whose role is to control the rhythm of the dance with the guns of baroud (powder). The large instrument (El-Khellaf) is often used, two to three, in the dances so that the role of the first "khellaf" is to direct and control the rhythm, the second is to maintain the balance of the troupe and it is essential, and the third is to create a link between the first and the second "khellaf" by filling the gap. As for the middle instrument, (Er-Rbâa), the use generally of a single piece is enough to raise and lower the musical balance. On the other hand, the small instrument (El-Aridja) is essential since it controls both the balance and the musical rhythm.

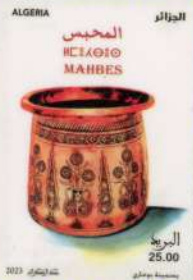

Pottery is one of the oldest crafts practiced by humans since ancient times. Algeria stands out for this craftsmanship across its entire territory, particularly in the wilaya of Tlemcen, which is renowned for the unique pottery in the village of "Bider," one of the hamlets under the commune of M'Sirda Fouaga. This village is famous for its production of traditional pottery, named after the region itself. This craft has been passed down from generation to generation for centuries, and despite this long history, the inhabitants have preserved the same decorative patterns used throughout time.

Mharmet Leftoul (scarf):

It is a piece of silk fabric, shiny, in the form of a scarf and finished with silk threads, often in silver, gold or in white. It is generally worn with the "Karakou of Algiers". It is one of the famous headdresses in Algeria.

Temahremt: Or Amendil, (floral scarf)

It is a symbol of shyness, with which the Kabyle woman covers her head. It is a square-shaped piece of fabric made of cotton silk, folded into a triangle that connects at both ends to end in a knot at the forehead.

Tachachit (headgear):

It is one of the traditional characteristics rooted in the inhabitants of the M'zab Valley. It is a part that makes up the traditional dress of men. It is also a symbol of elegance inherited from the local social heritage of the region.

The Amama (the turban):

Or the crown of the Arabs (as known), is often worn by both old and young peoples. Since it is not appropriate to expose one's bare head, especially among desert people and some urban families.



CULINARY HERITAGE

Algeria boasts diverse flora and fauna due to its varied landscapes, from Mediterranean coastal regions to the Sahara Desert. The Mediterranean climate supports rich plant life, including oak, olive trees, and cork oaks, while the desert areas are home to unique species like date palms and hardy desert shrubs. Wildlife in Algeria includes the endangered Barbary lion (historically) and native species such as the Saharan silver ant, Barbary sheep, and various migratory bird species.

Stenella Coeruleoalba :

These dolphins are characterized by a convex head, a curvy forehead and a short beak compared to Delphinus Delphis whose ventilation opening is located at the eye level. The length of the new born dolphins ranges between 0.8 to 0.1 m, reaching 1.7 to 2.1m at maturity.

This kind of dolphins usually spreads in the warm and temperate waters of the Atlantic Ocean. It is more concentrated in the Mediterranean Sea with the exception of the North Adriatic Sea. During summer, groups of more than 50 individuals steer for to the region of Annaba, Jijel, Algiers, the islands of Habiba, Oran and Ghazaouet.

This dolphin swims at a speed of up to 45 & 50km per hour, and it depends on a varied diet according to the areas of its presence, and which is mainly based on cephalopods in the Mediterranean Sea. Its life expectancy is estimated at 20 years.

Delphinus Delphis:

It is difficult to distinguish between Stenella Coeruleoalba and Delphinus Delphis especially when seen from far away. Delphinus Delphis makes small jumps with a maximum depth of 70m outside water. It repeatedly jumps to breathe for a short period from 1 to 3 seconds. It also swims and jump out of water and slowly rotates along the waves of ships.

At birth, its length is from 0.8 to 0.9m, when it reaches 2.2m at maturity and in rare cases, it reaches a length of up to 2.6m

This type of dolphin exists in the temperate and warm water of the oceans, but it has recently been noticed that it has begun to decrease in the Mediterranean basin, leaving place for Stenella Coeruleoalba because of it is the most affected and so sensitive to chemical and sound pollution in these waters. However, large groups still exist so far at Cap Rosa Gulf of Annaba), Cap El Hadid (Gulf of Skikda), Tenes and Cap Carbon (Gulf of Arzew).

These kind of dolphins move in groups called flocks consisting of 10 to 50 individuals and can be found in pair, or as isolated individuals. They swim at a high speed of more than 50km/h. They have a very developed maternal affection. Their average lifespan is from 25 to 30 years. They usually feed on sardines & anchovies, and some of the cephalopods such octopuses and squid.

HISTORY OF ALGERIA

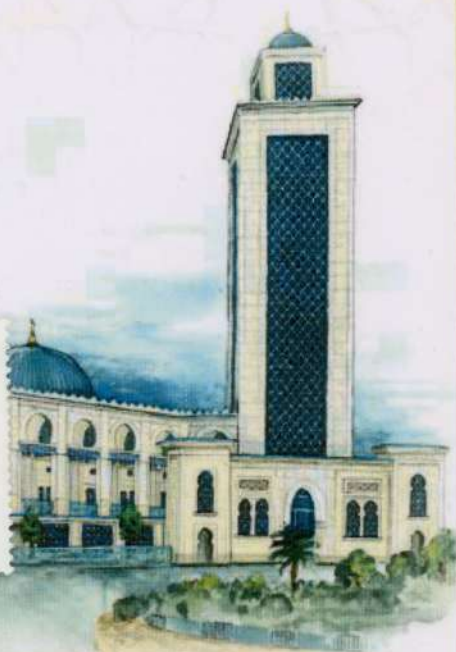

◀ The Mushaf of Algeria in Braille

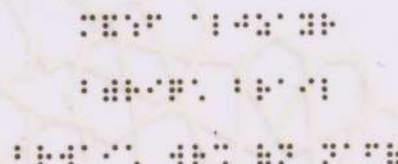
