## Joint Stamp Between Sultanate of Oman & Kingdom of Morocco





Commemorating the deep-rooted brotherly ties and the shared cultural heritage between the Sultanate of Oman and the Kingdom of Morocco. The design of the joint stamp captures the essence of both Oman and Morocco. The theme centers around the first place where the sun rises in the Arab region in Oman and the last place it sets in the Middle East in Morocco, symbolizing the breadth and unity of the Arab world.

In addition to featuring prominent cultural landmarks; including the majestic main gate of Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, the historic Sohar Ship, the serene sunrise at Ras Al Hadd, the formidable Sohar Fort, and the elegant Royal Opera House. Morocco's rich heritage is represented through its distinctive architectural style, the magnificent Al Hasan II Mosque, and iconic Moroccan sunsets.

## Joint Stamp Between the Sultanate of Oman and Kingdom of Saudi Arabia





Honoring the brotherly ties between the Sultanate of Oman and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, we are pleased to announce the launch of the joint stamp.

The stamp depicts the leaders of both countries with a palm tree in the center, signifying the nations' thriving partnership. The digital screen with red dots mark the capitals, Muscat and Riyadh, connecting the stamp to the future visions of both countries –Oman Vision 204, and the 2030 Vision of Saudi Arabia.

The stamp also illustrates the newly opened 725 km Rub AlKhali Highway (Empty Quarter Road), a direct route linking Oman to Saudi Arabia which emphasizes the importance in facilitating trade and cultural exchange. Overhead planes represent the strong bonds between the two countries and readiness to defend each other.

## Nebula and milky way in oman's sky









At the heart of the Middle East and under clear skies unspoiled by light pollution, Oman stands as the ideal destination for astronomy enthusiasts looking to explore the wonders of our infinite universe, from mesmerising nebulae formed from hydrogen, helium and oxygen to galaxies of varying sizes, spanning from dwarf to huge.

Oman's unspotted skies open a window to the cosmos, offering an unparalleled opportunity to observe magnificent celestial bodies and nebulae, such as the Horsehead Nebula and the Flame Nebula located thousands of light years away. Additionally, our very own galaxy, the Milky Way, can be seen with awe-inspiring clarity.

For the ultimate stargazing experience, the Ibri Province's Jabal Al Sarah is the highest mountain plateau in the Al Dhahirah Governorate (2,500m above sea level) and provides an elevated vantage point that makes for an optimal setting to observe the arc of our galaxy. Its visitors can also experience its biodiversity and stunning natural beauty, with thriving flora and wild trees like ironbark and tapiscia and various shade trees.

On the clearest of nights, the Milky Way's arc can also be spotted rising above the ancient Tombs of Kubaikib, deep in Jabal Abyad of the Nakhal Province. These captivating, -4000year-old conical tombs, shaped like beehives, date back to the Bronze Age.



The Omani presence in the East African region was most noticeable through the many important architectural monuments it left; represented by the many facilities, buildings, and urban archeology that still exist to this day and are considered an important witness to the Omani presence in the region, such as palaces, castles, mosques, tombs and other physical evidence that transformed a city like Zanzibar from a small village full of mud houses into a city with beautiful gardens, stone buildings, multi-storey houses, and more modernized structures.

## Freshwater Fishes of Oman





Oman Post issues a collection of postage stamps about Freshwater Fishes of Oman. Although arid habitats cover most parts of Oman (%82), the region has several freshwater systems that are vital for the survival of people as well as for different groups of plants and animals including variety of fishes. The diversity of inland fishes of Oman includes more than 23 recognized species which are classified in 15 genera, 10 families, 7 orders, and a class. They are found in the Wadis, Aflaj, Caves, Sinkholes, Brackish salt flats, and Artificial dams of Oman in three different area including: 1) Oman Mountains of Hajar and Dhofar, 2) Southwestern Arabian Coast, 3) Arabian Interior.




### **EXPO**




