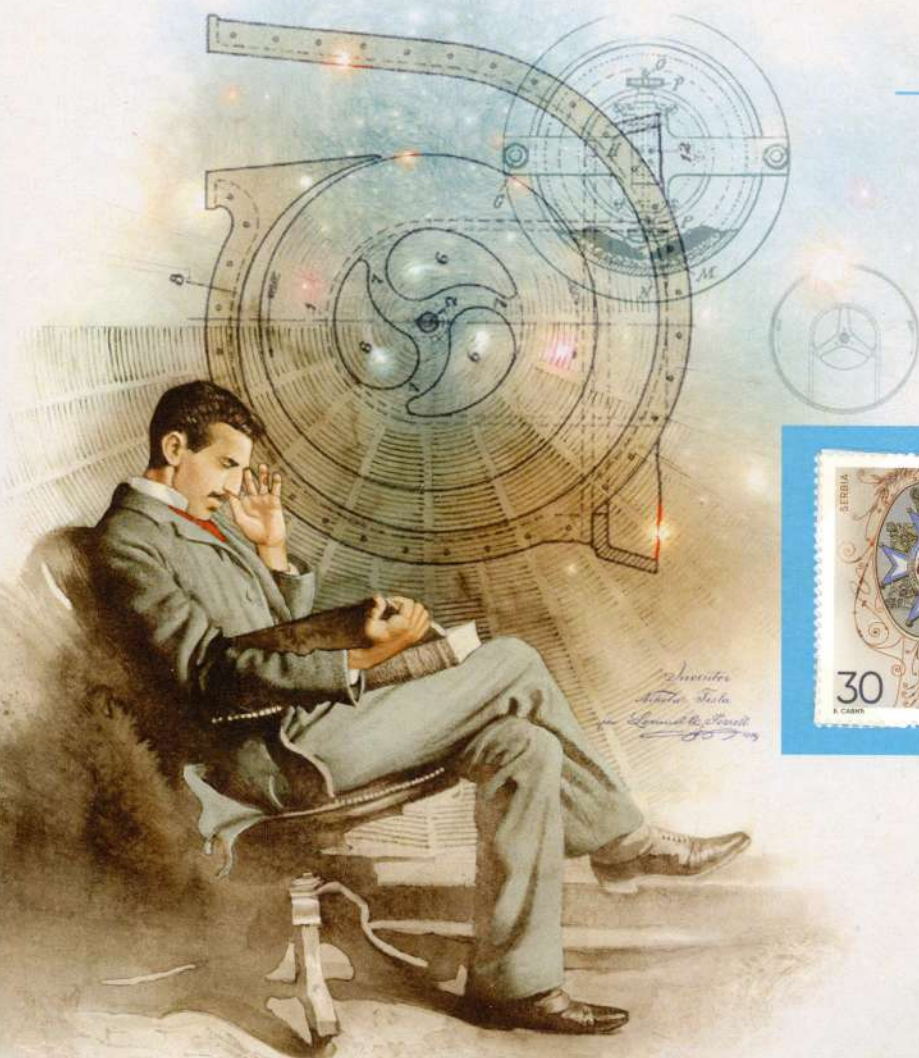

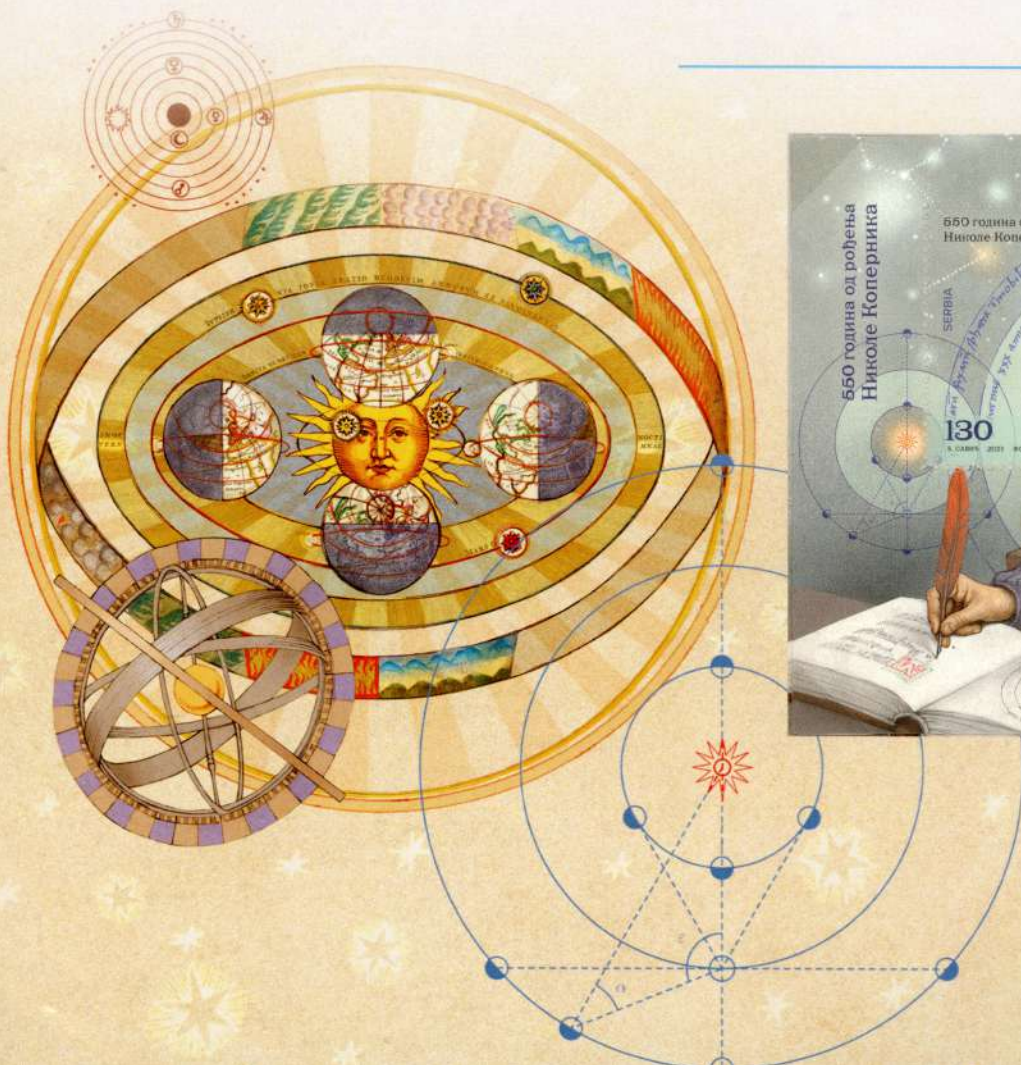

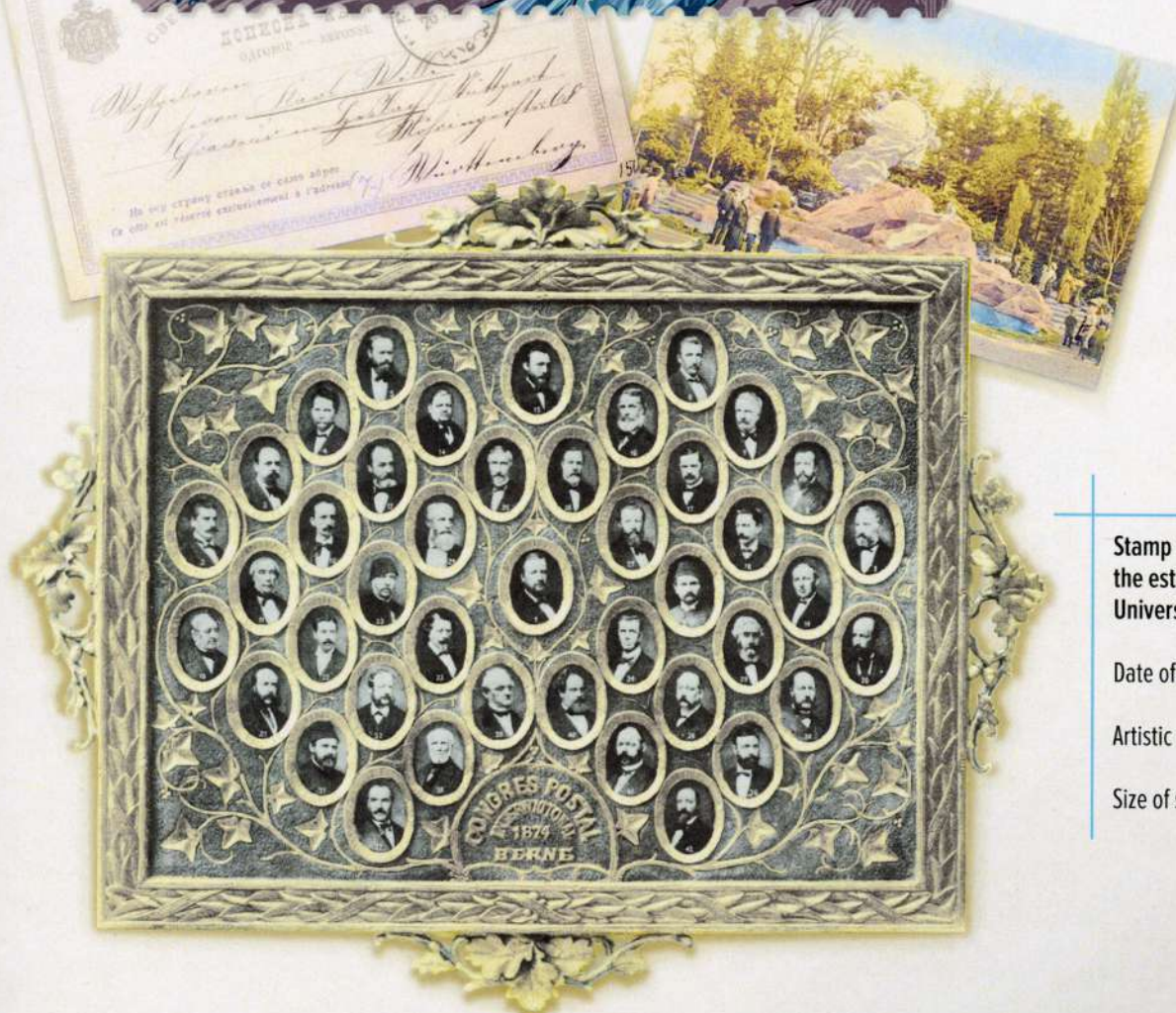


UNIVERSAL POSTAL UNION – 150 YEARS

The first Congress of the Universal Postal Union was held in Bern, from September 15 to October 9, 1874. The Congress was attended by designated representatives of 22 countries, including Serbia, represented by Mladen Ž. Radojković, whose portrait, together with the monument, symbol of the UPU, is shown on the stamp issued on the occasion of the 150th anniversary of the UPU. The philatelic specificity of this issue is the initials signature of the author of the stamp - the engraver's mark, which honours the historical role of the engraver in the production of postage stamps.

ECONOMIC PROGRESS OF SERBIA - RAILWAY DEVELOPMENT

The intensive economic development and progress of Serbia in the 19th century would not have been possible without the development of railway traffic and the economic connection of Serbia with European countries on one side and with the Ottoman Empire on the other. The most responsible for the construction of the railway infrastructure in Serbia 140 years ago were its ruler, King Milan Obrenović and Minister of Construction Jevrem Gudović, whose portraits are on the stamp published on the occasion of the 140th anniversary of the construction of the railway infrastructure in Serbia.

ART OF NADEŽDA PETROVIĆ

Nadežda Petrović, leader of modern art of the 20th century, art critic, author of a theatre play, co-founder of the Circle of Serbian Sisters, the Serbian Art Association, and the Paris League for the National Rights of Oppressed Peoples, as well as the first Serbian woman who took up photography, is one of the most famous and respected Serbian painters. On the occasion of the 150th anniversary of her birth, the Post of Serbia published selected works of Nadežda Petrović as motifs for commemorative postage stamps.

A LOOK AT CINEMATOGRAPHY

Fans and admirers of the seventh art in Serbia have always formed a numerous group, ever since the first film screening in Belgrade and the Balkans, held in 1896 in the tavern "Zlatan krst" (Golden Cross) at Terazije. The founding of the Yugoslav Film Archive in 1949, the collection of which includes about 100,000 copies, among them the documentary film "The Coronation of King Petar the First Karađorđević" from 1904 and the first Serbian live action film "The Life and Deeds of the Immortal Leader Karađorđe", from 1911 only strengthened and developed our love for film, as evidenced by the anniversary - 50 years of the international film festival FEST, but also a philatelic tribute to the world capital of film - on the occasion of the centenary of the installation of the Hollywood sign, which for a century has been carrying the message of universal culture around the world.

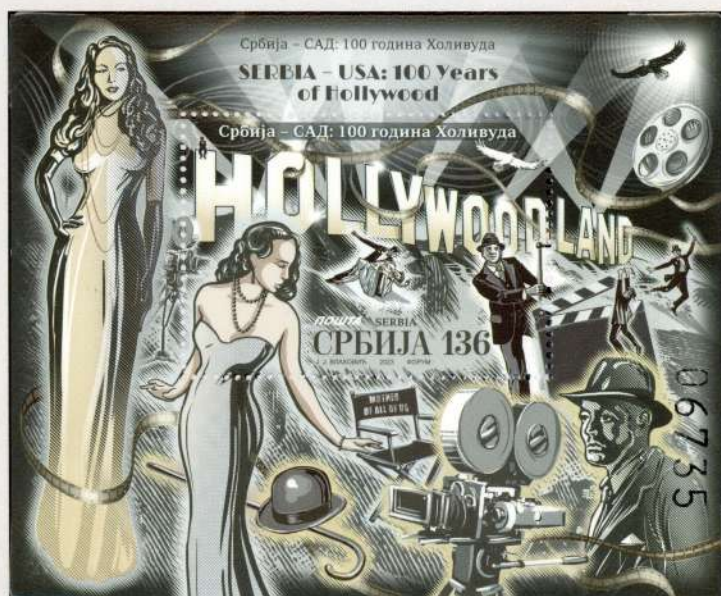

Patron Saint's Day (Slava) is a holiday dedicated to a Christian saint whom the family takes as its patron and protector, and dates back to early medieval times. Today, the majority of Orthodox believers in Serbia celebrate the Patron Saint's Day as a significant and traditional family holiday. Serbs perceive Patron Saint's Day as a way of expressing their Christian and national identity. Slava is a vital element of the intangible cultural heritage of the Serbian people, which was, in 2014, inscribed on the UNESCO Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

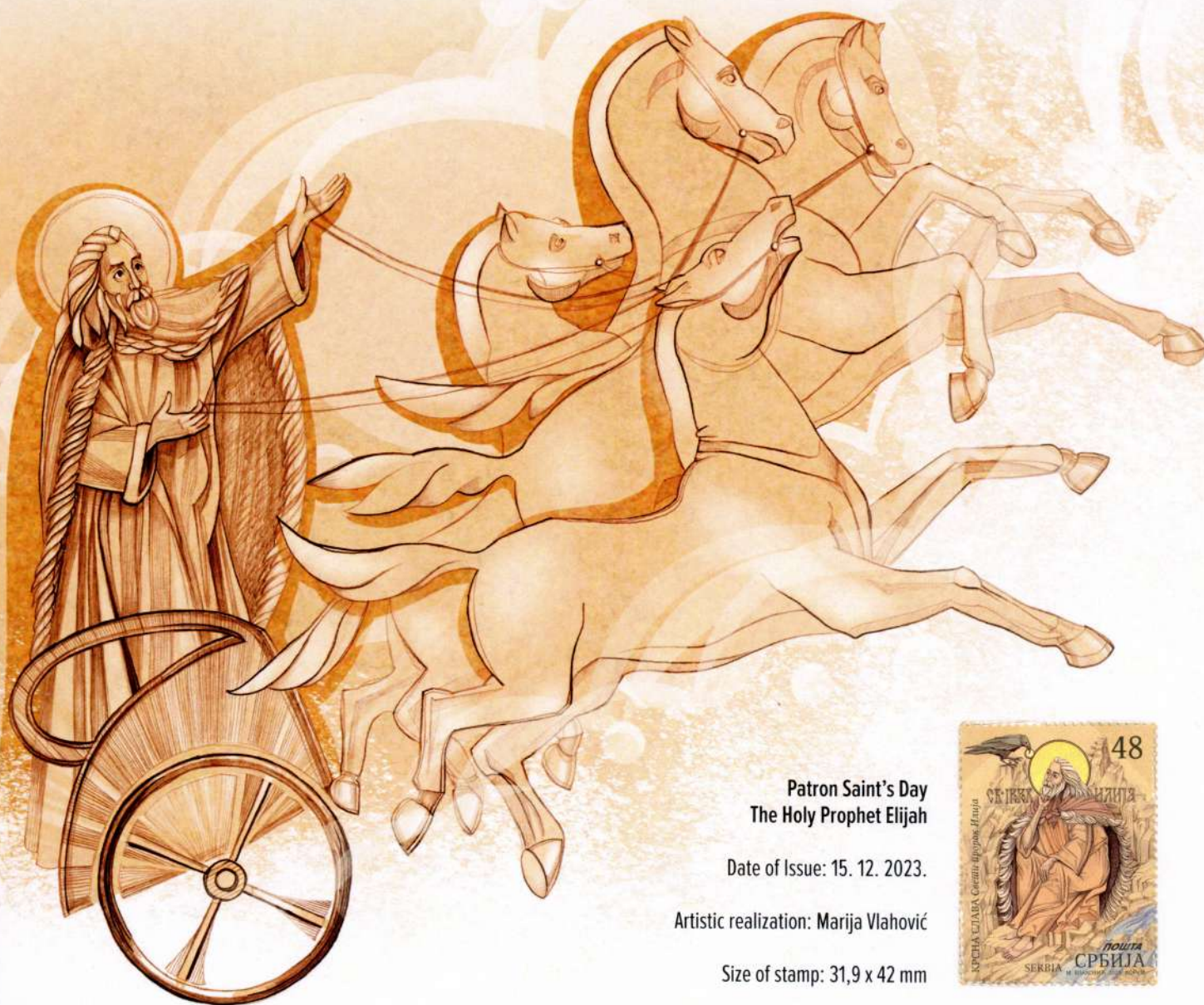
