

Although Karl Drais studied architecture, he did not foresee the entire architecture on his vehicle, as well as the brakes, but he still completed the first run successfully.

"Walter Defends Sarajevo" is a Yugoslav partisan film from 1972, directed by Hajrudin Krvavec, and written by George Lebovic, Momo Kapor, Hajrudin Krvavec and Sava Predja, while the film was produced by Hidajet Calkic. The film presents a free interpretation of the biography of a real anti-fascist fighter from the Second World War - Vladimir Peric Valter.

"Walter Defends Sarajevo" is an exciting, action-packed, detective story about Sarajevo illegals and their leader, partisan intelligence officer - Walter. This war film is the most popular partisan-war film made in socialist Yugoslavia and after half a century it is a cultural phenomenon. It is a reminder of the glorious time of Yugoslav cinema. At the time, partisan films were Yugoslav westerns and followed patterns of the popular American genre.

Oryctes nasicornis (Rhinceros beetle) inhabits the Palaearctic region, except for the British Isles. It prefers deciduous forests, located along the banks of rivers and above meadows.

Rosalia alpina Linnaeus, (Alpine longhorn beetle) inhabits the area from southern Sweden to the Balkan Peninsula, all the way to the Caucasus, i.e. Syria and Palestine.

Cerambyx cerdo Linnaeus, (Great capricorn beetle) is a Palearctic species whose range is decreasing, especially in the northern areas of Europe. It inhabits almost the entire Republic of Srpska in areas where there are oak forests.

Morimus funereus Mulsant (Beech Longhorn beetle) inhabits a wider area of Europe and is often present in deciduous forests in the Republic of Srpska.

Utricularia vulgaris L. is a perennial submerged plant from the Lentibulariaceae family. Lentibulariaceae has a branched stem that floats freely in the water without developed real roots, and can reach two meters in length. It is a strictly protected species in our country, because its populations are threatened by habitat loss.

Tench (*Tinca tinca* Linnaeus, 1758) is a freshwater fish from the carp family. It has a moderately elongated body and rounded fins. It is a widespread species in our country, but it is also strictly protected. It is protected because of overexploitation, as well as because of the endangered habitats it inhabits.
