Cathedral of Saints Peter and Paul in Gomieli is one of the most magnificent Orthodox churches in Belarus, with a height of 25 meters. It was built in a picturesque corner of Gomieli – on a high cape formed by the Sozh River and the Kiev Descent, according to the design of the architect John Clark in the classical style. Construction was completed in 1824. The temple was consecrated on May 9, 1824.

Church of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the village of Muravanka, Grodno region is a defensive-type temple built on an artificial hill, as it is commonly believed, in 1524 and incorporating Gothic and Renaissance features. The patterned vaults, typical of Gothic temples, are unusually artistic in the church. The powerful pillars-columns, dividing the room into three naves, seem to blossom at the top, disintegrating into many branches-petals.

Maliavanka (painted carpet) is a special type of folk art in Belarus. It is classified as a so-called naive art, a branch of primitivism. Maliavanka is a large (up to 2 meters) carpet, usually painted on homespun cloth painted in black.

Maliavanka became widespread in the period from the 1920s to the 1960s. They were hung on the walls of houses for decoration or as a talisman. Gradually, this type of art began to decline due to the development of factory carpet production.

Today, painted carpets can be seen in museums in Belarus. The largest collection (about 300 items) is in the collection of the Historical and Cultural Museum-Reserve "Zaslavje".

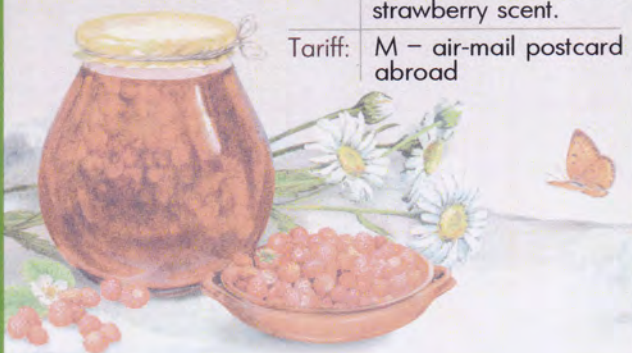

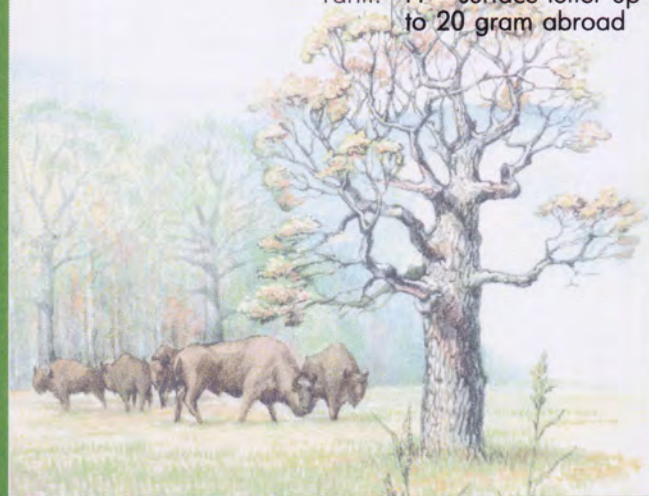

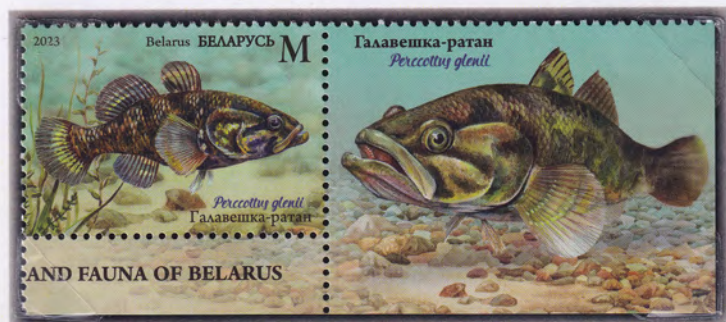

Carnivorous plants are able to catch and digest small animals, mainly insects, from whose bodies they obtain nitrogen and phosphorus (an additional source of nutrition), which allows these plants to grow where there are few of these elements. There are about 300,000 species of flowering plants (carnivorous are found only among them), of which over 600 species are carnivorous. There are 10 species of carnivorous plants growing in the wild in Belarus.

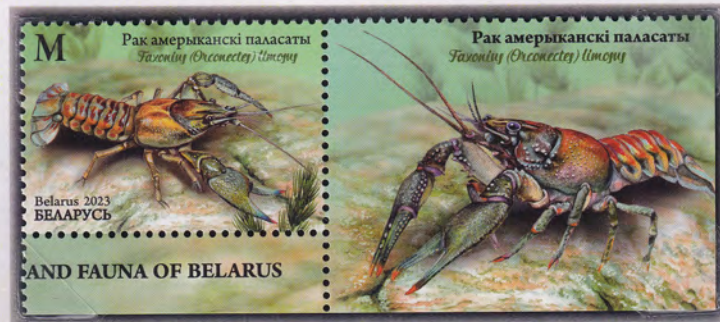

Stamp **Trolleybus 43300D. BKM Holding, 2019** shows a low-floor articulated trolleybus 43300D of the Vitovt series. First delivered to Viciebsk in 2019. It has an increased autonomous running of up to 20 km.

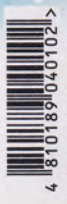
