As the stamps portray generations shielded by immunization, every feminine gesture keeps alive the fight for a healthier world, where care is transmitted, shared, and ultimately saves lives.

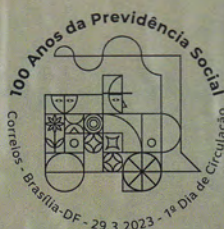

She claims – Each Constitution marks a turning point in Brazil’s path, and the 1934 Charter inscribed a historic truth: women had long earned the right to shape the nation’s future. This panel honors not only the evolution of legal texts but the emergence of women’s political presence—transforming silence into suffrage and suffrage into influence. As the pages of history turn, they echo the courage of those who demanded a voice in the decisions that govern life. The Constitutions portrayed here symbolize a country rewriting itself, while women step firmly into the chapter they helped create.

Their portraits of **Bertha Lutz**, **Carolina Bori**, **Enedina Alves**, **Graziela Barroso**, **Márcia Barbosa**, **Maria Deane** and **Sonia Guimarães** reflect not only their research but their power to redefine what expertise looks like. From amphibians to social structures, their work widens our understanding of life, a vision that continues to expand the universe of what humanity can know.

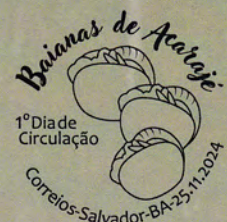

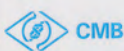

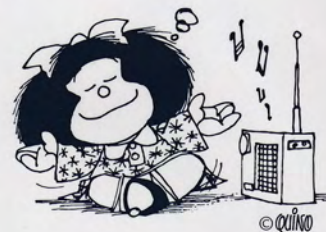
