**F**rantz Fanon was a committed anti-colonial intellectual who dedicated his work as a writer and psychiatrist to exposing the violence and racial foundations of colonialism, especially in Algeria.

Born in Martinique in 1925, he received a French classical education and joined the Free French Forces during World War II, an experience that shaped his political awareness.

After the war, he studied medicine in France and specialized in psychiatry. Appointed to the Blida hospital in Algeria in 1953, he confronted the brutality of colonial rule and observed the profound psychological harm inflicted on Algerians.

This experience transformed his thinking. Fanon rejected colonial psychiatry and engaged in the Algerian Revolution, insisting that individual healing was inseparable from collective liberation and that only the end of colonialism could enable true human reconstruction.

**T**he President of the Republic's Prize for Amazigh Literature and Language, established in 2020, honors outstanding literary, linguistic, and research works in all Amazigh language variants used in Algeria.

It covers linguistics, literature in or translated into Tamazight, research on Amazigh intangible heritage, and scientific and digital projects.

Evaluated by an independent jury, the prize promotes creativity in the Amazigh language and culture, with its fifth edition coinciding with the celebration of the Amazigh New Year 2975.

**A**lgeria is promoting economic diversification by supporting non-energy exports through a National "Quality Label" that certifies and enhances authentic agricultural products.

Several traditional products have received this label, strengthening their export potential, including Deglet Nour of Tolga, Dried Figs of Beni Maouche, and Bouhezza Cheese. Dried Figs of Beni Maouche, officially labeled in 2016, are valued for their traditional production methods, high nutritional content, and suitability for organic markets. Bouhezza Cheese, labeled in 2020, is a handcrafted product from the Aurès region, distinguished by its strong flavor, traditional aging methods, and high suitability for storage, transport, and international markets.

**W**ild herbs are a defining element of traditional Algerian cuisine, reflecting its diversity and close relationship with nature. Beyond enhancing flavor, these plants enrich dishes with important nutritional and medicinal benefits.

Several emblematic dishes rely on wild herbs as key ingredients. Purslane cooked in derssa is a popular seasonal dish valued for its distinctive taste and high content of omega-3 and iron. Couscous with Spanish thistle (guernina) celebrates spring and combines couscous with a sweet, vitamin-rich wild plant common in central and eastern Algeria. Chakhchoukha with slender mallow (khubiza), prepared mainly in inland and high plateau regions, blends shredded flatbread with a nutritious leafy herb rich in fiber and antioxidants.

Together, these dishes illustrate how wild herbs are central to Algerian culinary heritage, combining tradition, health, and a deep connection to the natural environment.

**A**lgiers Houari Boumediene International Airport, opened in 1940, is one of Africa's largest airports, serving 20 million passengers annually across four terminals. **K**ey figures in Algerian theater include Mahieddine Bachtarzi, a pioneer who founded troupes and shaped the national theater; Keltoum (Aïcha Adjouri), one of the first prominent Algerian women in theater and cinema; Ould Abderrahmane Kaki, creator of the Garagouz troupe and notable plays; Abdelkader Alloula, director inspired by traditional halqa storytelling; Azzedine Medjoubi, actor, director, and educator; and Sakina Mekkiou (Sonia), actress, director, and promoter of women in theater. Together, they forged Algeria's theatrical heritage, combining tradition and modernity while training new generations of artists.

**A**lgerian women have played a central role in preserving national identity by transmitting traditional attire and customs across generations.
