

Imagine having the set of the original Star Trek series as your own private playground as an eight- or nine-year-old.

Chris Doohan, son of the late James Doohan — better known as Montgomery “Scotty” Scott, chief engineer on the Starship Enterprise — doesn’t have to imagine it. He lived it back in the 1960s.

Chris was in Toronto for the introduction of a new series of Canada Post stamps marking the 50th anniversary of the pioneering sci-fi series — and honoring crew members with Canadian connections, including his dad.

TORONTO — Canada Post is beaming Scotty onto a new stamp.

The Crown corporation announced Friday that Star Trek’s Montgomery Scott — known affectionately by his Enterprise crewmates and fans as “Scotty” — will be featured on its fourth stamp in a series honouring the 50th anniversary of the sci-fi TV series.




Canada Post will include a permanent-rate stamp showing actor John Colicos as Klingon Commander Kor when its Star Trek 50th anniversary set is issued May 5.

The last two stamps to be revealed in Canada Post's upcoming Star Trek 50th anniversary set both represent the fierce Klingon Empire: longtime foes of the Federation forces that include Captain James T. Kirk and the crew of the starship Enterprise.

The full Star Trek stamp set will be issued May 5, according to Canada Post.






