Instructions for UPU road safety assessment tool

- 1 Complete the questions on each tab relating to each of the road safety pillars: road safety management, safer road users, safer vehicles, post-crash response and building sustainable systems.
- 2 Assign a score for each question, whereby:
 - 1: no system;
 - 2: system designed but not developed;
 - 3: system under development; or
 - 4: system developed.

Note. – only one number should be assigned per question. Please enter the number in the corresponding column for that line.

- 3 Add comments in the comments section to explain the score assigned for each question.
- 4 Each tab will calculate the total score for that pillar.
- 5 The scores for each pillar will be summarized on the “Score” tab to provide an indication of overall strengths and opportunities. If top scores were assigned for each area, the chart will show a full pentagon.
- 6 The designated operator is invited to create a road map to address the areas for improvement and recognize areas of strength.
- 7 Completed assessments and road maps may be shared with the UPU International Bureau by e-mail at security@upu.int. In so doing, the designated operator will qualify for inclusion in future road safety recognition initiatives.

The aim of this tool is to increase road safety awareness and engagement, and to support continuous improvement. The ultimate goal of the UPU road safety programme is to reduce or eliminate road accidents and injuries.
