Money order evolution

- Payments exchanged via letter mail since 18th century: Stable until mid-20th century
- Evolution of computerized systems and dematerialized paper-based payments
- Democratization of IT
 - Emergence of money transfer operators (trademark centred)
 - Evolution from postal money orders to electronic postal money orders

The PosTransfer trademark



History

Creation and development of the UPU PosTransfer trademark started in late 2013 (2013.2 POC)



Activities

- Creation of the PosTransfer logo
- Worldwide registration of the trademark
- Postal Payment Services User Group tasked with the development of the trademark
- Development of a set of PosTransfer promotion materials
- In parallel, preparation of the PosTransfer quality of service standards and tools
- Deployment of the trademark





The Postal Payment Services User Group (PPSUG) supported by the UPU Financial Services team

- Countries in all regions have adhered or in the process to implement PosTransfer
- Early adopters: Djibouti, Senegal and Moldova

Countries / designated operators members of the PPSUG profit from:


- Free use of the trademark


Background

Mid-1990 the Postal Technology Centre at the UPU created the IFS software suite




2016 UPU Istanbul Congress
